

## FUNERAL OF MR. W. R. LEFANU, M.I.C.E.

Yesterday the remains of the late Mr Wm R LeFanu, C E, ex-Commissioner of the Irish Board of Works, were removed from his late residence, Summerhill, Enniskerry, to the local churchyard for interment. The great respect entertained for the deceased gentleman was testified in a marked degree by the attendance at the funeral. The line of carriages reached a long distance along the road from Summerhill towards the Dargle, and the cortege on foot comprised the peers and peasants of the district and representatives of commercial and official classes of the city and suburbs. The massive oak coffin, which was strewn with wreaths and floral crosses, bore the following inscription—

WILLIAM RICHARD LEFANU,  
Born 24th Feb, 1816.  
Died 8th September, 1894.

At the special request of the working people of Enniskerry the coffin was carried from Summerhill to the churchyard.
