**I Lieutenant** Colonel ffrancis William Cashell late of His Majestys [10th] Regiment of ffoot do hereby make this my last Will and Testament and give and bequeath to my only and dear Sister Mary Ann Cashell the whole of my property of every description

and I do hereby appoint my loving Uncle John Guise Rogers Esq<sup>re</sup> of Holmer Lodge in the Parish of Holmer in the County of Hereford my sole Executor in fulfilment of this my last Will

In Witness whereof I do hereby sign my hand and Seal this third day of December at Cheltenham in the County of Gloucester in the year of our Lord one thousand eighteen hundred and seventeen *F W Cashell (SS)* Lt Colonel 2 Battn 10 Regt Witness *George Madeyon /—/ Josiah Holdship /—/ Tho<sup>s</sup> Clark* X his Mark
